Band Check-In

- When you first arrive at Veterans Stadium, please come to Band Check-In, located by the performance entrance. You will receive any last-minute information or schedule adjustments.
- Band Check-In will open at 9:00 a.m.

Performer/Staff Entry

- Your WBA staff passes will allow entrance into the stadium all day. Please keep visible when entering the stadium.
- Performers in uniform/costume do not need to wear wristbands for performance, as all uniformed students will be admitted.
- Performers out of uniform will need a wristband given to you at Band Check-In.
- All pit crew/non-uniformed personnel will need to have a Pit Pass or official WBA pass in order to be admitted to the Stadium. Please inform your students and staff of these policies.

Bus/Truck Parking

- Please follow instructions on the performance schedule as to what gate to enter. Your vehicles must enter in the correct gate in order to reach your assigned parking area.
- Please refer to Contest Site Maps for your band's assigned parking area.

• WBA volunteers will be on hand to meet you upon arrival and will give your drivers parking instructions.

Band Warm-Up

- Please see enclosed maps for designated warm-up areas.
- Be considerate of the band performing on the field and make sure your band is facing a direction that will not disrupt the performances in the stadium. There can be no sound bleed into the stadium.
- The use of Dr. Beats, jam blocks, other time keeping devices and the use of long rangers and megaphone amplification devices cannot interfere with the performances occurring in the stadium. Any band using these devices during their warm-up and disrupting a competing band in the stadium will face a ONE POINT penalty to be assessed by the chief judge.
- It is your responsibility to manage your warm-up and report to the performance entry at your designated time.
- Your pit and props should move toward the stadium 15 minutes prior to the rest of the band.

Motorized Vehicles in the Stadium

• At no time may a motorized vehicle be inside the performance area of the field. They can only be driven on the turf surrounding the field and not on the performance field, the end zone or the white sideline.

Hash Marks

• High School markings dividing the field into equal thirds, 53'4" from the front and back sidelines.

Restrooms and Changing Facilities

- There will be portable restrooms located in the Bus/Truck parking lots as well as restrooms in the stadium.
- Locker rooms will be open for dressing as well as additional restrooms will be open in the center of campus. Refer to the map for locations.

Band Food Service

- Grilling and open flames are prohibited in the Bus/Truck parking areas.
- Outside food and beverages are NOT allowed in the stadium. Please inform your students and boosters of this policy.
- Please do not leave any garbage behind in your parking area; it is your responsibility to clean up after your band and remove all trash.

Finalists

• The top three (3) from each of the 1A, 2A, & 3A classes plus the next six (6) highest scores will advance to the 1A-2A-3A Combined Grand Championship. Bands will perform in reverse order of class championship score regardless of class.

Tiebreaker Rule

- WBA tiebreaker rule states that whenever a tie occurs, the band that has the higher score in General Effect will become the higher placing band. If GE scores are tied, then the Music score will break the tie.
- Ties are broken only with each class of competition to determine placement. However, if two bands tie from two different classes are progressing into Grand Finals, then the tie will be broken to determine order of performance.

• Should two bands at the "break point" tie for progression into Grand Finals, the tie is broken for performance order purposes but both bands will be allowed to advance.

Awards

- Finale will be drum majors, captains and seniors only. Groups should report to Performance Entrance at conclusion of performances.
- Medallions for individual members of the champion in each class.
- Championship banner for the champion in each class.
- Trophies presented to top three (3) bands in each class
- Commemorative plaques for each band.
- Caption awards in each class as follows:
 - Best Music: highest Individual Music score plus highest Ensemble Music score
 - Best Visual: highest Individual Visual score plus highest Ensemble Visual score
 - Best Effect: highest Music Effect score plus highest Visual Effect score
 - Best Auxiliary: highest total Color Guard score
 - Best Percussion: highest total Percussion score

Inclement Weather

• In the event of inclement weather, decisions regarding championship performance schedule will be communicated to all participating bands via text, email, and website posting.

Spectator Information

- There is ample spectator parking at stadium (see enclosed map). There is no fee to park in spectator lot.
- Ticket sales will only be sold near the spectator/band entrance at the northwest side of the stadium. Ticket office opens at 8:30 am.
- Outside food and beverage are **NOT** allowed into the stadium.
- Tripods or other similar equipment that may obstruct the view or path of travel of others in seating areas are not allowed and will be removed by stadium personnel.

Photography & Video

- WBA has been advised that the director's educational copy provided to each group at past championships is contrary to the position of music rights holders and licensing agencies who represent them. There remain unresolved legal questions with regards to "fair use" in this situation. WBA has decided not to provide educational copies to groups participating at this year's championships until further discussions can occur in the hopes of finding a solution that is acceptable to all parties.

- Tripods or other similar equipment that may obstruct the view or path of travel of others in seating areas are not allowed.



Band Check-In

- When you first arrive at Fresno State Bulldog Stadium, please come to Band Check-In, located by the performance entrance near the Performance Entrance Ramp (see Contest Overview Map). You will receive any last-minute information or schedule adjustments.
- Band Check-In will open at 11:00 a.m.

Performer/Staff Entry

- Your WBA staff passes will allow entrance into the stadium all day. Please keep visible when entering the stadium.
- Performers in uniform/costume do not need to wear wristbands for performance, as all uniformed students will be admitted.
- Performers out of uniform will need a wristband given to you at Band Check-In.
- All pit crew/non-uniformed personnel will need to have a Pit Pass or official WBA pass in order to be admitted to the Stadium. Please inform your students and staff of these policies.

Bus/Truck Parking

- There are two (2) Bus/Truck parking areas. The White lot is located off of Millbrook Avenue. The Red Lot entrance is on Cedar Avenue. Please refer to the Contest Site Overview Map for your band's assigned parking area.
- WBA volunteers will be on hand to meet you upon arrival and will give your drivers parking instructions.
- Personal vehicles are prohibited in the Bus/Truck parking areas.

Band Warm-Up

- Please see Stadium and Contest Overview Maps for designated warm-up areas.
- Be considerate of the band performing on the field and make sure your band is facing a direction that will not disrupt the performances in the stadium. There can be no sound bleed into the stadium.
- All warm up areas are grass surfaces.
- The use of Dr. Beats, jam blocks, other time keeping devices and the use of long rangers and megaphone amplification devices cannot interfere with the performances occurring in the stadium. Any band using these devices during their warm-up and disrupting a competing band in the stadium will face a ONE POINT penalty to be assessed by the chief judge.
- It is your responsibility to manage your warm-up and report to the performance entry at your designated time.
- Your pit and props should move toward the stadium 15 minutes prior to the rest of the band.

Motorized Vehicles in the Stadium

• At no time may a motorized vehicle be inside the performance area of the field. They can only be driven on the turf surrounding the field and not on the performance field, the end zone or the white sideline.

Ramp Dimensions

- The width of the ramp leading down to the performance field is 14' wide
- There is a scoreboard obstructing the height of the ramp that limits height at 12' and projecting 8' wide over ramp

Pit Equipment Safety

- All pit equipment will enter the stadium from the South ramp. Due to university risk management, each band's pit equipment will be required to connect to a security device at the top of the ramp.
- Contest personnel attach a safety hook to a solid location on your rig just in case of brake failure. This same system will assist your rig in exiting the stadium.
- All pit and prop crews must follow directions of contest personnel. We do this for safety reasons and appreciate your cooperation.

Hash Marks

The field will have TWO sets of markings

- High School markings dividing the field into equal thirds, 53'4" from the front and back sidelines. We will chalk these hash marks for the event.
- NCAA markings 60' from the front and back sidelines, 40' apart. These will be permanent.

• Please inform your students and visual staff. You may want to consider painting college hash marks on your practice field prior to this event.

Restrooms and Changing Facilities

- There will be portable restrooms located in each of the Bus/Truck parking lots as well as restrooms in the stadium.
- Because of the limited facilities for changing, we encourage you to come in uniform.

Band Food Service

- Grilling and open flames are prohibited in the Bus/Truck parking areas per Fresno State University. University police will be patrolling these areas to insure adherence to this policy.
- Outside food and beverages are NOT allowed in the stadium. Please inform your students and boosters of this policy.
- Please do not leave any garbage behind in the picnic area; it is your responsibility to clean up after your band and remove all trash. Bands not following this policy may be assessed a fee post-event should Fresno State University charge WBA for cleanup of your parking area.

Finalists

• The top three (3) from each of the 4A & 5A classes plus the next nine (9) highest scores regardless of class will advance to the 4A/5A Combined Grand Championship. Bands will perform in reverse order of class championship score regardless of class.

Tiebreaker Rule

- WBA tiebreaker rule states that whenever a tie occurs, the band that has the higher score in General Effect will become the higher placing band. If GE scores are tied, then the Music score will break the tie.
- Ties are broken only with each class of competition to determine placement. However, if two bands tie from two different classes are progressing into Grand Finals, then the tie will be broken to determine order of performance.
- Should two bands at the "break point" tie for progression into Grand Finals, the tie is broken for performance order purposes but both bands will be allowed to advance.


