Welcome to another exciting year of the THHS Instrumental Music Program! Listed below are information and forms to be completed and returned for the 2017-2018 school year.

1. Band Camp & Orchestra Summer Camp Information – This sheet details dates and times of these camps and what to bring. Since there is no Jazz Camp, those musicians do not receive this form.
2. Student Information Sheet – For marching band and color guard members, please bring this completed form to the **first day of (Rookie) Band Camp**. Orchestra students, please bring this completed form to the **first day of Orchestra Summer Camp**. Jazz Ensemble members, please bring this completed form to class the **first week of school**.
3. Emergency Card – For marching band and color guard members, please bring this completed form to the **first day of (Rookie) Band Camp**. Orchestra students, please bring this completed form to the **first day of Orchestra Summer Camp**. Jazz Ensemble members will be given this form in class at a later date. **NOTE: NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE AT (ROOKIE) BAND CAMP OR ORCHESTRA SUMMER CAMP WITHOUT THE EMERGENCY CARD COMPLETED, SIGNED AND RETURNED!**
4. Clothing Order Form – Students from all ensembles are required to wear blue THHS Instrumental Music polo shirts at all events when not in uniform. They cost \$25 each and checks can be made out to THHS Music Boosters. **NOTE:** The first football game at which marching band and color guard members may be performing, is on Friday, September 01, 2017, blue polo shirts will be mandatory.
5. Marching Unit Picture Day Flyer – The Marching Unit will take a formal group photo on Wednesday, September 27, 2017. Individual photos will also be available. The photo order form will be passed out to students during the first week of school. This is for marching band and color guard members only.
6. WELCOME TO THHS BINGO!

THHS Instrumental Music Program launched Bingo 8 years ago as a way for the Music Program to raise money to help financially support our award-winning Program. It has grown into one of the most popular bingo sites in Orange County.

Bingo is every Thursday, 3:30 p.m. - 10:15 p.m. We need approximately 30 parent volunteers each Thursday night to successfully run bingo. On average we have 125 players a night! **FOR REAL!!!**

Let's Talk THHS Music Boosters' Bingo:

Why do we have a Bingo program?

- Bingo started out as a supplemental fundraiser for the music program. It has grown into our largest fundraiser for the THHS music program. BUT, it is not our only source of fundraising.
- Our Director is given an annual budget from the school district to run the program. However that budget only covers the basic curriculum. It does not cover the cost of additional activities that help shape our kids and give them a robust music experience: coaches, festivals, concerts, competitions, performance events, transportation to events, family pot luck, awards dinner and so much more.
- **NOTE: Funds from BINGO supports ALL Ensembles – Chamber Strings, Intermediate Orchestra, Marching Band, Color Guard, Percussion Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Symponic Band**

How can I help?

- We need volunteers, approximately 30 volunteers needed each Thursday night.
- **If one parent from all ensembles works 1 shift at bingo once a month, we will always be fully covered.**
- Help is needed from 3:30-10:30pm. There are many jobs and shifts.
- There are many positions and shifts that need coverage. (See table on next sheet). The Opening and Closing Shifts are the hardest to fill.
- No experience is necessary, just a friendly attitude and willingness to help.

What should I expect?

- To Have Fun while meeting people and helping our kids' music program
- You will be moving, so wear comfortable shoes.
- Never worked Bingo? No worries! We will train you on site.
- There are a few positions that require special training and we are always looking for new folks to show an interest: VP/Manager, Treasurer, Caller, Buy-In Table, Open Hospitality, Board and Audio Set-Up.
- The table on the next page shows the various positions and shifts and volunteers needed.

How to sign up to Volunteer:

We will go over this at the parent meeting.
