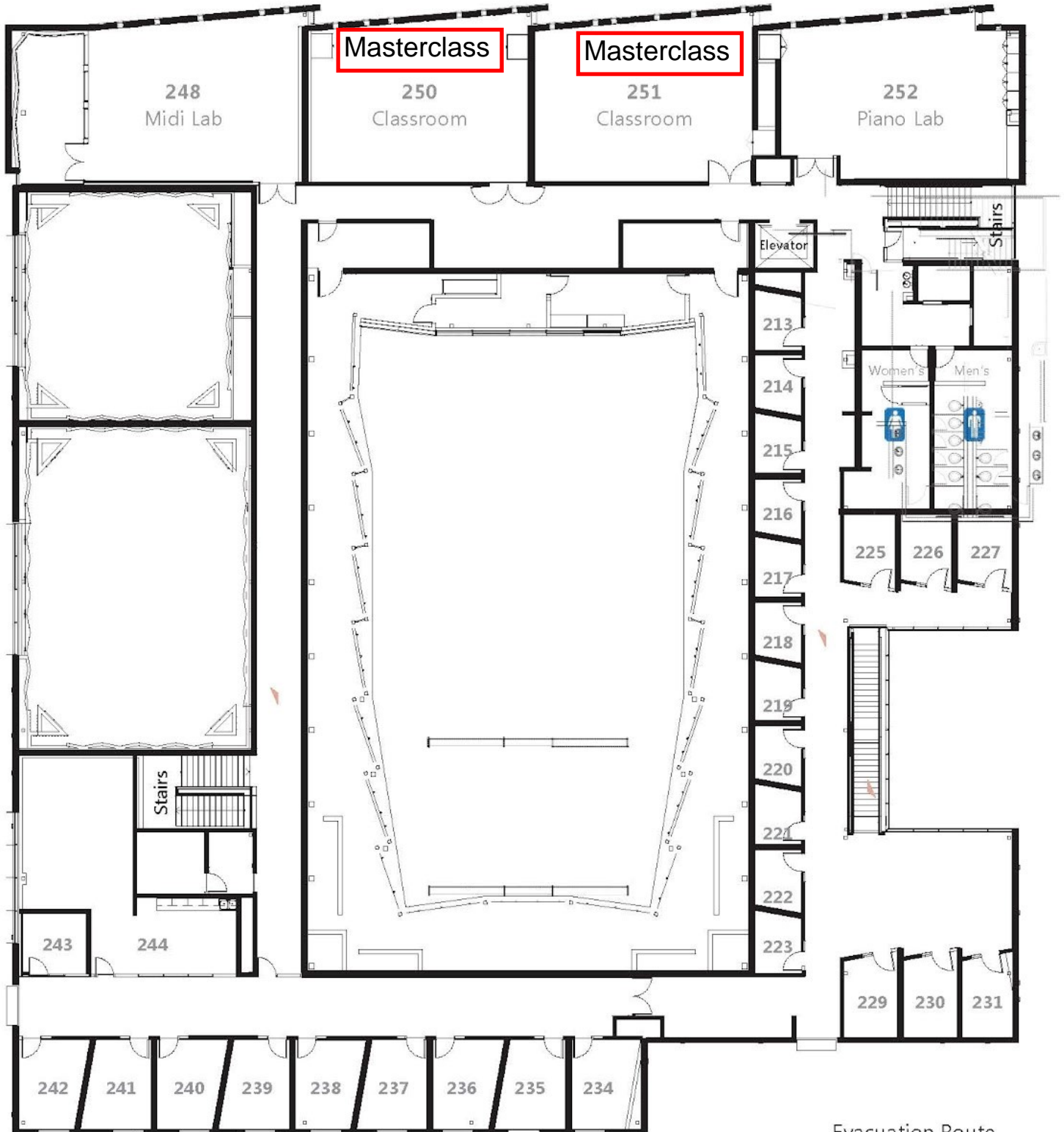
## 1st Floor map
