SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Spectator Parking: Due to the large number of bands in attendance, parking is limited. Premier Spectator parking \$10 (Cash only. Valid for one-time entry with no re-entry.) on campus is available via Bulldog Blvd (off Peyton Drive). Free ADA Parking is available in Premier Parking. Free spectator parking is available across the street at the Community Center and at the Library/City Hall on Peyton.

Tickets: Tickets can be purchased via the WBA Website. Cash will NOT be taken for ticket sales. Assistance with purchasing tickets will be provided at the entrance.

General Admission: \$20

Military/Senior/Kids 5-12: \$18

Kids 4 and Under: Free

Plan ahead to allow extra time if purchasing tickets at the gate. We strongly recommend buying tickets online in advance. Please note that a clear bag policy will be enforced. Non-clear bags, such as camera bags, will be subject to search.

Concessions: Concessions will be located just past the entrance. Cash, credit card, Apple Pay and tap to pay will be available. Offerings: Burgers, hot dogs, tacos, fries, nachos, smoothies, kettle corn, and more!

Restrooms: Restrooms for spectators are located at the entrance, next to the concession stand.

ENSEMBLE INFORMATION

Check-in: All ensembles **MUST** check-in at our off-site check-in located at Gerald F. Litel Elementary School: 3425 Eucalyptus Ave, Chino Hills, CA 91709. Upon arrival, all vehicles are required to check in by completing the vehicle log. Following check-in, Ensembles will be provided with unit-specific parking instructions.

Bus Parking: Buses will enter at "Gate B" to drop off students. Because space is limited, buses must leave the Ayala campus after dropping off students and park in the designated bus parking areas. Buses are **NOT** allowed to remain on the Ayala campus. After drop-off, Buses will be directed to park at either McCoy Equestrian lot or LDS Church back lot. You will be notified at check in.

Semi & Truck Parking: Semis will remain on the Ayala campus. Equipment trucks (trailers and box trucks) should enter through Bulldog Blvd and then turn left to unload and then proceed to their designated parking areas. A parking supervisor will provide directions once you check-in. Box trucks and trailers directed to park off campus may return to the loading/unloading **AFTER** performance for loading. 15 Minutes is allocated for each loading/unloading.

Warm Up: After drop-off, enter the quad area through the double red front gate; no cars or trucks are allowed inside. Ensembles may warm up in the quad or back field, and lights will be provided in both areas, but there will not be staff guiding groups to warm-up locations. During warm-up, please face away from the stadium. For performances, staging is along the back (east side) road and the exit the stadium and push along the top of the parking lots (front side) toward the loading/unloading zone. The First Aid Station is located inside the Ayala Bulldog Stadium. Please help keep the campus clean by picking up all trash and leaving nothing behind.

Prop Staging: After unloading, props can be moved through the Bulldog Blvd gates to the staging area on the basketball courts.

Performer Restrooms: There are restrooms located outside the gym and outside of the MPR.

Field Surface: The field is artificial turf marked accordingly. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the field at any time.

Power on Field: Power will be available at the front sideline near the 50-yard line. You are responsible for having a backup power source in case of an outage.

Medical/EMS: There is a field-side first aid tent with at least one nurse, EMT, or equally qualified volunteer at the tent within easy reach during the entirety of the event.

Retreat: Drum majors and ensemble captains should report to the BAND STAGING ENTRANCE of the field prior to the final performance to begin preparing for retreat.

Hospitality: Directors, staff members, and event staff can enjoy Ayala hospitality at the VIP tent located to the northeast of the field. Adjudicators will have their own separate "Judges' Lounge" in the Science Building, Room F113


Judges/Ensemble Critique: The critiques will be held in the Judges' Area on the southeast side of the field.

Credentials: All Ensemble staff and chaperones should have a WBA Credential for entry into the stadium. Anyone without a credential will be asked to purchase a ticket. Directors, Staff, WBA Event Staff, and Adjudicators should have WBA Credentials in order to enter the Hospitality area.

Competition Suite: Adjudicator commentary for all WBA ensembles can be located in Competition Suite (CS) shortly after the conclusion of each ensemble's performance. Directors may grant CS access to the staff/instructors, and may request help from WBA to resolve any issues accessing CS.


SITE OVERVIEW MAP


SITE OVERVIEW MAP SEMI/TRUCK EQUIPMENT PARKING
