

#### **Tickets and Seating**

Tickets for each day of Prelims are \$20 and are all general admission. The box office and arena doors open 30 minutes before each event. Seats are available on a first come, first served basis. Children five and under are free.

#### **Video and Photos**

Tripods and/or monopods are prohibited in the stands. <u>No video recording is permitted</u>. Still photography, without a flash, is welcome.

#### **Spectator Parking**

All spectators and staff vehicles will park in the East Parking Structure (PK2 - please see Layout link).

#### Truck & Bus Parking

Ensemble parking is guaranteed for busses, trucks, semis, and carpool vehicles carrying six (6) or more performers. Due to lot capacity, all other vehicles must park in the East Parking Structure on a first come, first served basis. Drop-offs cannot be accommodated. <u>No motorhomes are allowed at SCPA events.</u>

Trucks and busses will arrive and unload in parking lot H at the designated time (please see layouts, maps, and schedules) and remain there during your ensemble's warm-up and performance time. Immediately after your performance and group photo, trucks will need to be reloaded, and then all vehicles will need to relocate to parking lot N for the remainder of the day. Vehicles must vacate parking lot H within 60 minutes after your performance concludes to make room for other ensembles. Lot H is a silent zone.

If you plan to feed your ensemble during the event please do so in Lot N, in an open space on campus, or off-site. Lot H is for loading and unloading only.

The same process will be used with Rounds 2 and 4 to select the final six wildcard semifinalists in PSA.

The top three ensembles in each PSA Semifinals round will advance to Finals. The final six slots in Finals will be filled by the next six highest scoring wildcard ensembles from either round of Semifinals.

The top three ensembles in each PSO round will advance to Finals. The final six slots in Finals will be filled by the next six highest scoring wildcard ensembles from either round.

The top scoring groups in PIA, PSCA, PIO, PSCO, PSCW, PSW, and PIW advance to Finals.

Regardless of rank, a minimum gross score of "70.00" must be achieved in order to advance to Finals.



Participant Information

## Welcome to SCPA Championship Prelims for PIA, PIO, & PIW and Semifinals for PSA!

#### **Tickets and Seating**

Tickets for each day of Prelims are \$20 and are all general admission. The box office and arena doors open 30 minutes before each event. Seats are available on a first come, first served basis. Children five and under are free.

#### **Video and Photos**

Tripods and/or monopods are prohibited in the stands. <u>No video recording is permitted</u>. Still photography, without a flash, is welcome.

#### **Spectator Parking**

All spectators and staff vehicles will park in the East Parking Structure (PK2 - please see Layout link).

#### Truck & Bus Parking

Ensemble parking is guaranteed for busses, trucks, semis, and carpool vehicles carrying six (6) or more performers. Due to lot capacity, all other vehicles must park in the East Parking Structure on a first come, first served basis. Drop-offs cannot be accommodated. <u>No motorhomes are allowed at SCPA events.</u>

Trucks and busses will arrive and unload in parking lot H at the designated time (please see layouts, maps, and schedules) and remain there during your ensemble's warm-up and performance time. Immediately after your performance and group photo, trucks will need to be reloaded, and then all vehicles will need to relocate to parking lot N for the remainder of the day. Vehicles must vacate parking lot H within 60 minutes after your performance concludes to make room for other ensembles. Lot H is a silent zone.

If you plan to feed your ensemble during the event please do so in Lot N, in an open space on campus, or off-site. Lot H is for loading and unloading only.

There will be no overnight parking at this event. Please make alternate arrangements.

#### Restrooms

Restrooms are available in the arena for those with a wristband. Portable restrooms are also available in the truck/bus parking lot (H).

#### **Ensemble Warm-Up**

All warm-up will take place in lot G according to the logistics schedule (see attached). Warm-up in other areas on campus or at other times is prohibited. Floor tarps (both "practice" and "performance") are not to be pulled out during warm-up. See "Layout" diagram for warm-up orientation. <u>Face your ensemble in the direction indicated by the arrow</u>. All equipment must be removed from the warm-up area before you depart for your performance.

#### Warm-Up to Arena Transit

Ensembles departing the warm-up area to push to the arena will use the cement walkway for entrance transit.

Ensembles exiting the floor folding area will use the paved access road to push back to the truck/bus parking lots. Please see Layout for maps.

#### **Pre-Stage**

As your ensemble approaches the arena doors, you'll be able to pre-stage some of your equipment and/or instruments inside the arena, with the rest remaining in the tunnel until your scheduled performance time. Once the group on the floor begins their performance, the arena doors will close and remain so for the duration of the performance. We recommend arriving with a clear plan concerning what and/or who your ensemble chooses to stage in the arena and in the tunnel. Those in the arena need to ensure they are not a distraction.

#### **Designated Staff & Sound Engineer Locations**

Please see the diagram linked in Layout for designated sound engineer and staff viewing locations. There are two staff viewing locations (one high, one low), each of which can accommodate approximately seven people. There is to be no sitting on the stairs or aisles.

The staff viewing area is reserved for staff of the currently performing ensemble. After your ensemble has performed, please find an alternate seating location to enjoy other performances.

#### **Ensemble Photo**

After your performance, proceed to the floor folding area, where you'll have one interval time to fold your floor. Please be mindful of time, as another ensemble will be out shortly. Then, proceed to the ensemble photo area a short way down the access road and leave your equipment in one of the two designated spaces. Once you've taken your photo, return your equipment to the bus/truck lot using the access road.

#### **Awards Retreat**

Retreat for all Prelims rounds will be captains only. Retreat for PSJ Finals will be a full retreat for all performing members. All those participating in retreat need to report to the floor folding area immediately following the last performance.

#### Advancing to Semifinals & Finals

The top three ensembles in each PSA prelims round will advance to Semifinals. The final 12 slots in Semifinals will be filled by wild card ensembles. Rounds 1 and 3 will be adjudicated by the same panel of judges; as such, these scores will be comparable. The next six highest scoring ensembles from Rounds 1 and 3 will advance to Semifinals. The same process will be used with Rounds 2 and 4 to select the final six wildcard semifinalists in PSA.

The top three ensembles in each PSA Semifinals round will advance to Finals. The final six slots in Finals will be filled by the next six highest scoring wildcard ensembles from either round of Semifinals.

The top three ensembles in each PSO round will advance to Finals. The final six slots in Finals will be filled by the next six highest scoring wildcard ensembles from either round.

The top scoring groups in PIA, PSCA, PIO, PSCO, PSCW, PSW, and PIW advance to Finals.

Regardless of rank, a minimum gross score of "70.00" must be achieved in order to advance to Finals.



## Campus Map






## Warm-Up Lot






## Warm-Up / Arena Transit Flow





- Take I-15 Freeway North
- Take I-10 Freeway West
- Exit Milliken Avenue (exit 57) and turn left
- Turn left on Concours Street
- Turn right on Ontario Center Parkway
- Citizens Business Bank Arena will be on your left-hand side

## Welcome to the SCPA Championship Finals!

#### **Tickets and Seating**

Ticket prices are \$30, \$40, and \$50 for individually ticketed areas. General admission is \$25. General admission spectators are welcome to sit in the individually ticketed areas until the ticket holder arrives. Children two and under are free if sitting in a parent's lap. Anyone needing a seat will need a ticket.

#### **Video and Photos**

Tripods and/or monopods are prohibited in the stands. <u>No video recording is permitted</u>. Still photography, without a flash, is welcome.

#### **Spectator Entrance**

Spectators with a ticket will enter through the main entrance doors, which are located in the southeast corner of the arena (please see maps linked in Layout). Per arena guidelines all backpacks, purses, and bags will be searched prior to entry.

#### Spectator / Staff Parking

All spectators and staff vehicles will park in lots A, B, or C. (please see maps linked in Layout). Parking will be \$15 per vehicle (cash only).

#### **Truck & Bus Parking**

Ensemble parking is guaranteed for busses, trucks, semis, and carpool vehicles carrying six (6) or more performers in lot F (please see maps linked in Layout). All other vehicles must park in the paid spectator lots. Drop-offs cannot be accommodated. The truck and bus area of lot F is a silent zone.

#### Restrooms

Restrooms are available in the arena for those with a wristband / ticket. Portable restrooms are also available in the truck/bus parking lot (F).

#### **Ensemble Warm-Up**

All warm-up will take place in lot F according to the logistics schedule (see attached). Warm-up in other areas or at other times is prohibited. Floor tarps (both "practice" and "performance") are not to be pulled out during warm-up. See "Layout" diagram for warm-up orientation. Face your ensemble in the direction indicated by the arrow. All equipment must be removed from the warm-up area before you depart for your performance.

#### Warm-Up to Arena Transit

Ensembles departing the warm-up area to push to the arena will use gates F3 and E to push to the ramp down to the arena floor. Keep left on the ramp.

Ensembles exiting the floor folding area will keep left when going back up the ramp and use gates D and F2 to push back to the truck/bus parking lot. Please see maps linked in Layout.

#### **Designated Staff & Sound Engineer Locations**

Please see the diagram linked in Layout for designated sound engineer and staff viewing locations. There are two staff viewing locations: the lower location can accommodate exactly seven people; the upper location can accommodate approximately seven people, including the sound engineer. Please plan accordingly in advance. There is to be no sitting on the stairs or aisles.

The staff viewing area is reserved for staff of the currently performing ensemble. Please remain seated for the duration of your ensemble's performance. After your ensemble has performed, please find an alternate seating location to enjoy other performances.

#### **Awards Retreat**

Retreat for Finals is a full retreat for all performing members. All those participating in retreat need to report to the floor folding area immediately following the last performance.

SCPA encourages performers to wear any medals previously earned at SCPA or WGI events for Finals retreat.






