BY START OF PRACTICES 6/23/21

- 1. <u>Gloves:</u> These can be ordered online from Peacock's Marching World @ www.marchingworld.com or Amazon also has them; around \$25 (Ever-Dri Performance Gloves by DSI in tan)
- 2. Knee Pads: Athletic volleyball type
- 3. <u>Water jug</u>: Minimum 32oz, this is not optional. You are to have one at every rehearsal and it is not to be shared with anyone for sanitary reasons
- 4. **Sunblock and Chapstick:** 45+spf: for protection from the sun during summer outdoor rehearsals
- 5. **Sunglasses** for protection from bright sunlight during rehearsals
- 6. **Baseball Cap**: **Required** to be worn at all outdoor daytime rehearsals
- 7. <u>Pen/pencil & notepad</u> Beyond your dot book, there will be times that staff will have you do activities which require paper & writing utensil.
- 8. **Black & white (for rifles only) electrical tape** Can be purchased inexpensively at Daiso, Walmart, Target, etc.
- 9. <u>Extra hair ties & Bobby pins and/or hair clips</u> Your hair is to be back, off your neck, at all times; sharing is not allowed for sanitary reasons.

- 10. **Yoga Mat or large beach towel** used to sit on for body warmups / stretching in the various outdoor area where we rehearse.
- 11. <u>Tissues, Band-Aids, Femine products</u> You will get injured, this is a sport, so please be prepared with some kind of small first aid kit as to not solely rely on the school's kit; example Target sells in the \$.99 travel bins. WELCOME TO THHS BINGO!

It's our 11th Anniversary this year!!!! The Music Boosters started bingo as a fundraiser to help support our AWARD-WINNING MUSIC Program. It has become one of the most popular bingo sites in Orange County! Bingo is EXCLUSIVE to the Music program. All profits go into the THHS Music program. We anticipate this fundraiser coming back in January 2022.

This is serious BINGO! Payouts range from \$250 - \$1,199. We average 120 players every Thursday and many of them are regulars. The players like the special attention they receive from the volunteers.

Bingo is every Thursday, 3:30 p.m. - 10:15 p.m. AS CRAZY AS IT SOUNDS... It takes a minimum of 30 - volunteers each Thursday night to run bingo successfully. On average we have 120 players a night! FOR REAL!!!

Why Bingo?

- Bingo started as a supplemental fundraiser for the music program. It has grown into our largest fundraiser for the THHS music program. BUT, it is not our only source of fundraising.
- The Music Director is given an annual budget from the school district to run the program. However, the district
 budget only covers the basic curriculum, meaning it covers basic music classes and nothing more. It does not
 cover the cost of additional activities that help shape our kids and give them a robust music experience:
 coaches, festivals, concerts, competitions, performance events, transportation to events, family pot luck,
 awards dinner and so much more. These additional events are what makes the THHS MUSIC experience so
 impactful on our kids.
- NOTE: Funds from BINGO support ALL Ensembles Marching Unit, Color Guard, Percussion Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Strings, Intermediate Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band

How can I help?
