Driving Directions:

From the 405 (San Diego) Freeway:

1. In Costa Mesa, exit @ Harbor Blvd. & go south (see director's notes regarding important arrival instructions)
2. Proceed past Baker St. (stop light) & Adams (stop light) to Fair Drive and turn left onto Fair Drive
3. Go to Fairview Road and turn left onto Fairview Road.
4. Costa Mesa High School Bus parking is on the right, just past Arlington and across the street from O.C.C. Buses and equipment vehicles turn into this parking lot on the right by either the Theater or the Gym.
You will be directed as to where to park (see warm up area schedule).
5. Spectator parking – Spectator parking will be offered across the street from Costa Mesa High School on Fairview Road @ Orange Coast College in lots C & D. There is a parking fee of \$5.00. Limited parking will also be available at Davis Elementary School on Arlington, just past the stadium.
6. Warm up areas will be designated and are limited to inside the campus area, as not to bleed sound into the stadium. Color Guards may warm-up in free campus spaces, as long as there is no sound bleed into the stadium.
7. Bands will go from warm-up areas, through the blacktop to the stadium.

Dear Directors and Bands,

We are very excited to have you participate in our 35th Annual ***South Coast Invitational*** Marching Band Tournament. The Costa Mesa High School Band Boosters have been working hard to make this an enjoyable and memorable event for you, your students, and your band families, and we wish you the best of luck in competition and throughout the season. As a band director, I feel it is my mission to send my students out with positivity and inspiration for the future. We are competitors, but first and foremost, we are musicians and collaborators. So, let's compete hard and support each other & our activity even more!

Tournament Site –

We are excited to host the 35th Annual *South Coast Invitational* at our stadium, on the campus of Costa Mesa High School. It has an artificial turf field with a wonderful track and is a great performing venue. This is our 5th time hosting our tournament on our own campus and we are so very excited to be back once again! Our stadium is financially in a two-phase plan in regards to seating and some other items, the backside stands in particular are limited. We will be setting up extra seating where possible. I will leave it up to you as directors of your programs to instruct your students on where you would like them to be.

*******IMPORTANT ARRIVAL/PARKING INFORMATION*******

(Costa Mesa High School – 2650 Fairview Road, Costa Mesa CA 92626)

The police department has asked that all Busses & Equipment Trucks enter the parking lots on Fairview – GOING NORTH. (They want all busses/trucks to turn right from the right lane to enter the parking lots.) This is NOT the direction you would be going if you entered Fairview right off the 405 Freeway, so this is what I suggest to those groups coming from the 405 Freeway:

– Exit the 405 on HARBOR BLVD. – go South. Turn left on Fair Drive & then turn left onto Fairview Road. Now you will be going North on Fairview. Your group may be directed to the main bus parking lot on the far end of campus by the gym or the first parking lot with the CMHS Performing Arts Center. **(See the schedule to determine which lot you will be entering** – those in warm-up C will be in the lot by the theater).

Arrival –

Upon arriving, you will receive a show day packet, which will include wristbands for your performing students, adult wristbands for your parent volunteers, as indicated previously. All other spectators may purchase tickets at the ticket booth by the spectator entrance. **Tickets are: General Admission \$10, Students \$5, Kids 5 and under are free.**

Spectator Parking –

Due to two events being held at the O.C. Fairgrounds on our tournament day, we will not be able to offer spectator parking across the street at the Fairgrounds this year. **Orange Coast College** has graciously offered parking for spectators for our event this year. O.C.C. is located on Fairview Road, across the street from Costa Mesa High School. Once parked at O.C.C., cross Fairview Road at the corner of Merrimac in Lots C & D (you will see the CMHS Performing Arts Center on the corner) and follow the sidewalk down Arlington to the stadium. There will also be limited parking at Davis Elementary school (about 75 spots) on Arlington next to the stadium.

Warm Ups –

Follow the warm-up area schedule. Please be careful with the volume of your percussion sections and **NO “Dr. Beat” or amplified metronomes!** Face your group away from the stadium, when needed, as not to interfere with the performance on the field. Please do not play in the quiet zone – pathway to the stadium on the blacktop. (See warm-up area schedule & map)

Entering the Field –

All bands enter the stadium from the band gate and go on the field from “stage left” - the back of the field. Pits and props enter the stadium through the front gate and then line up on the track to the left. All motorized vehicles are asked to stay off the main field area. You may drive around the track. After the performance, bands will exit through the same gate that they entered. **Remember the band that is next to perform always has priority through the gate.** Be courteous and wait for them to clear before exiting. CSBC rules apply to all performance situations. Costa Mesa High School will provide electrical power in front of the field @ the 50 yard line, but in the case of a blown fuse, you are responsible for a backup generator.

After Your Performance –

Students, Staff & Parent volunteers must have their wristbands or staff badges to re-enter the stadium.

Director/Staff Hospitality –

Please visit the director/staff area, which is located in the stadium on the grassy area next to the concession stand. You will see it as you enter the field with your band. We have planned a wonderful assortment of refreshments for you!

Concessions–

A full line of wonderful food & concessions at reasonable prices will be available for your group, so please take advantage of this. We will be providing a variety of food at our concession stand, including lunch, snacks, drinks & desserts. We really do appreciate your patronage. We truly appreciate you supporting our concessions.

***NMUSD does NOT allow preparation of large amounts of food on any NMUSD Campus. (This includes barbeques and table set ups that impede parking & the flow of the tournament. This is per school district policy and may be enforced at tournament time. Parking will be tight as there is only one awards, so please do not take over another group’s parking area. Thank you 😊**

Awards –

Student leaders should meet under the scoreboard immediately after the final performance (Woodbridge H.S.). Please have them line up in performance order. Trophies will be given per the CSBC guidelines.
