SPECTATOR & STAFF PARKING

Spectators and staff can park in the Fourth St. Parking Lot. **All parking will cost \$10** – Cash or Venmo Only. Please use Fourth St. (from either direction).

TICKETS

Tickets \$30 Adults, \$25.00 Military with ID, \$20 for Children 5-12, and \$0 for Children under 5. Cash and Card accepted at the box office. BUY TICKETS ONLINE.

PROGRAM

A souvenir program will be available for purchase for \$10 at the table near the box office. Cash and Credit Card Accepted.

MERCHANDISE SALES:

There will be a PEPWEAR Booth selling various t-shirts and other items.

<u>CONCESSIONS</u>: There will be concessions offering food and beverages. Your support of our concession sales and vendors is greatly appreciated. Food preparation of any kind on the campus except for the official concession stand is prohibited. No BBQ, fires, or open flames are permitted anywhere on the property. **CASH ONLY**

PHOTOGRAPHY

Tripods or other similar equipment that may obstruct the view or path of travel of others in seating areas are NOT allowed. Any liability associated with unauthorized recordings will rest with the individual or organization making the recording. WBA does not condone or accept liability for any unauthorized recording during the event.

CAMPUS RULES

No coolers or ice chests, or outside food may be brought into the stadium. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted. No BBQ or fires permitted anywhere on Chaffey High School property. Smoking is not allowed.

CHECK-IN:

Please check in on arrival. Band check-in will be at the corner of Fourth St. & Vine.

BUS PARKING/ ARRIVAL:

- See maps for directions on how to get to Bus Parking (please only ENTER at Fourth St. & Vine). We are only using 1 (one) gate for entrance into this parking lot.
- ☼ Please refrain from warming up in the parking lot. It is a safety hazard to have groups warming up while other groups are parking.
- Students will receive a wristband when they get off the bus. Directors, Staff, Media, and Pit Crew/Chaperones will need to use their official WBA credentials for admission to the stadium. If your chaperones wish to sit on the home side, they will be asked to purchase a spectator wristband from the ticket booth. Any volunteers who wish to sit on the home side must purchase wristbands at the box office.

SILENT AREAS: The Final Staging/ Exit Areas inside the stadium are designated SILENT AREAS.

<u>WARM-UP</u>: Please ask your Percussion Sections to Warm-Up facing away from the Stadium. Color Guard Warm-Up only in the North/South Quad Field Area, with any music playing away from the stadium.

STAGING AREA: The final staging area prior to competition is located at the southeast side of the stadium near the Racquetball Courts

PROP DROP-OFF: Prop Drop off is accessed through the Fifth St. entrance down a drive towards the stadium. The available drop-off area is quite long and narrow. Please have enough volunteers to unload in the designated area. You can return props here after your performance and pick up later or you can take your props back across campus to your trucks.

<u>FIELD & HASH MARKS</u>: Regulation High School field with Standard Hash Marks. Front Sideline markers will be on the field.

ELECTRICAL POWER: There will be one extension cord available for you to plug into for electronic/power needs on the track at the 50-yard line.

BAND FIELD EXIT: Please exit the field through the northeast gate (near the Visitor Entrance/Box Office).

MOTOR VEHICLES: NO STREET-LEGAL VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED INSIDE THE STADIUM. Motorized vehicles (golf carts, john deer gators) only are allowed inside the stadium. Each band is responsible for transporting their equipment to and from the stadium.

<u>PIT/PERCUSSION INSTRUCTIONS</u>: Pit equipment and support vehicles should report to the Band Entrance in front of your Band (southeast side of the stadium on the home side). They <u>do not</u> need to be there earlier than your band...just in front of your band. It's highly recommended to give your pit plenty of time to get to the staging area. Navigating Chaffey should be easy as there are plenty of wide, smooth pathways. Please pay attention to the enclosed walking map. Timing from Bus/Truck/Trailer to band entrance is approximately 10 mins and from Warm Up Area to band entrance is 5 mins.

<u>ADJUDICATORS COMMENTS:</u> The WBA uses a software program called *Competition Suite*. Please refer to the WBA website under forms to make sure you are signed up for this before you arrive.

STUDENT/ CHAPERONE SEATING: Students will be able to be seated on the visitor side, with reentrance allowed with a performer wristband. The student sections are at both ends of the visitor side seating, and a chart is enclosed to guide your students to their designated area. **Subject to Change, based on responses from the survey.

STAFF VIEWING/SOUND MIXING: Lower-level viewing is available on the sideline. There will be an upper-level reserved section at the 50-yard line. Please have your WBA credential visible.

ANNOUNCER: The announcer will be in the press box. Wired mic. If this changes, we will communicate the change.

CRITIQUE: Critique will not be at this event.

<u>WEATHER</u>: Should there be rain on the day of the Show, warm-up areas will be moved indoors/under covered areas. The WBA is responsible for final judgment on adjustments to the show schedule. Volunteer staff will relate any changes as necessary.

FIRST AID/HEALTH/SAFETY: It is IMPERATIVE that each participating group has with them their emergency card for each student. If some emergencies were to arise, it would greatly help our first aid volunteers to have the appropriate information, so they can provide the necessary care that would be required. Basic first aid will be located on the plaza outside the spectator entrance to the stadium. For moderate issues, call Ontario Police Department at 1(909)-395-2001. For severe emergencies, call 911. Stay hydrated.

HOSPITALITY: Hospitality is located in the Second Floor Classroom Adjacent to the Gymnasium. The stairway entrance can be accessed from the track (look for signs) and requires the WBA official directors or staff credentials. Food and beverages will be served throughout the event. Please see the map.

<u>SATURDAY</u>, <u>NOV 19 AWARDS CEREMONY</u>: There will be three awards ceremonies for each class. Please send Drum Majors/Senior/Leadership (anyone the director chooses) to the tunnel entrance at the start of the last band's performance. Please refer to the schedule online.

<u>SUNDAY, NOV 20 AWARDS CEREMONY</u>: There will be one award ceremony. Please have an entire band at the tunnel entrance at the start of the last band's performance. Please refer to the schedule online. No instruments, but in uniform.

WBA ADJUDICATORS & EVENT STAFF: Parking for adjudicators and WBA staff will be in District Parking Lot. There will be coned-off spots for you to move the cone and park.







SEATING

Performers and chaperones with WBA Field Passes not permitted on the home side – must have a paid admission to sit on the home side. Additionally, there will be 400 folding chairs on the track for spectator seating.

CHECK-IN: Corner of Saunders and Terracina once you turn into campus.

BUS PARKING/ ARRIVAL: *Trucks/Trailers* in Lot E off City College and Saunders. *Buses* can pull in for dropping off then repark across the street in Lot U.

<u>Staff/Chaperones</u> must park across the street from campus in Lot Q off City College and Saunders and use ParkMobile app to pay – **ZONE 14220**.

☆ Students will receive a wristband when they get off the bus. Directors, Staff, Media, and Pit Crew/Chaperones will need to use their official WBA credentials for admission to the stadium. If your chaperones wish to sit on the home side, they will be asked to purchase a spectator wristband form the ticket booth. Any volunteers who wish to sit on the home side must purchase wristbands at the box office.



RESTROOMS: There will be 4 portable restrooms in the truck parking lot and also restrooms/locker rooms in the Huntley Gym (see map).

SILENT AREAS: The Final Staging/ Exit Areas inside the stadium are designated SILENT AREAS.

WARM-UP: Lower-level of campus only! Lots F, G, and P adjacent to Truck Parking. Colorguards can use practice fields next to parking structure and stadium or tennis courts near truck parking.

STAGING AREA: The final staging area prior to competition is located at the east end of the stadium (side 2) near the scoreboard and next to the swimming pools.

PROP DROP OFF: Props must be unloaded in the truck parking lot and then brought to stadium staging area. This is a 10-15 minute walking pace, depending how deep in the lot you're coming from.

<u>FIELD & HASH MARKS</u>: Turf with College Hashes at 60' and 100' from sideline. Regulation High School Hashes will be taped in YELLOW at 53'4" and 106'8". *Pressbox is off-center by about 15 yards, center on side two 35.*

ELECTRICAL POWER: There will be one extension cord available for you to plug into for electronic/power needs on the track at the side one 45-yard line.

BAND FIELD EXIT: Bands and pits will exit together from the front sideline back toward the same get they entered for performance. WHEN EXITING stay along the inside track lanes to allow entering bands to use the outside track lanes.

MOTOR VEHICLES: NO STREET-LEGAL VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED INSIDE THE STADIUM. Motorized vehicles (golf carts, john deer gators) only are allowed inside the stadium. Each band is responsible for transporting their equipment to and from the stadium.

<u>PIT/PERCUSSION INSTRUCTIONS</u>: Pit equipment and support vehicles should report to the Band Entrance in front of your Band (east end, side two, of the stadium). They <u>do not</u> need to be there earlier than your band...just in front of your band. *Allow 10-15 minutes of transit time from the parking lot area to reach stadium staging.*

<u>ADJUDICATORS COMMENTS:</u> The WBA uses a software program called *Competition Suite*. Please refer to the WBA website under forms to make sure you are signed up for this before you arrive.

STUDENT & CHAPERONE SEATING: Seating is going to be tight. Students and Chaperones will sit on the away side or either endzone area. PLEASE SEE ATTACHED MAP. Seating is NOT assigned, but please look at the seating section capacities to choose a section best suited for your group, and be aware that there will still most likely be bands sharing seating areas.

STAFF VIEWING/SOUND MIXING: Lower-level viewing is available on the sideline. There will be an upper-level reserved section at the 50-yard line. Please have your WBA credential visible.

CRITIQUE: There will be no critique at this event.

WEATHER: There is no rain expected as of 11/10. Should there be rain on the day of the show, warm-up will be moved inside but very limited. WBA is responsible for final judgment on adjustments to the show schedule. Volunteer staff will relate any changes as necessary.

<u>FIRST AID:</u> Basic First Aid provided at Performance Gate, east end of the stadium at scoreboard. For emergencies call 911. <u>RCC Police Dispatch</u> (951) 222-8171 • <u>Riverside Community Hospital</u> (951) 788-3000 across the street from RCC.


