Welcome to another exciting year of the THHS Instrumental Music Program! Listed below are information and forms to be completed and returned for the 2022-2023 school year.

1. Band Camp & Orchestra Summer Camp Information – This sheet details dates and times of these camps and what to bring. Since there is no Jazz Camp, those musicians do not receive this form.
2. Student Information Form – Orchestra students, please bring this completed form to the **first day of Orchestra Summer Camp**. For members of the marching unit (band/drumline/guard), please bring this completed form to the **first day of (Rookie) Band Camp**. Jazz Ensemble and Wind Ensemble only members, please bring this completed form to class the **first week of school**.
3. SVUSD Athletic Information Form – Orchestra students, please bring this completed form to the **first day of Orchestra Summer Camp**. For members of the marching unit (band/drumline/guard), please bring this completed form to the **first day of (Rookie) Band Camp**. Jazz Ensemble members will be given this form in class at a later date. NOTE: **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE AT (ROOKIE) BAND CAMP OR ORCHESTRA SUMMER CAMP WITHOUT THE EMERGENCY CARD COMPLETED, SIGNED AND RETURNED!**
4. Pre-Participation Sports Screening Evaluation/Physical Examination Form – For members of the Marching Unit (band/drumline/guard), please review the flyer with the instructions to complete the sports screening and submit online through AthleticClearance.com prior to the first day of Rookie Band Camp. *This is a new process for 2022 – to be completed by July 22, 2022!* Orchestra, Jazz Ensemble and Wind Ensemble only students do not require this form.
5. Clothing Order Form – Students from all ensembles are required to wear blue THHS Instrumental Music polo shirts at all events when not in uniform. *New for 2022:* All spiritwear will be ordered online through a local vendor. NOTE: The first football game at which marching band and color guard members may be performing is on Thursday, September 01, 2022, blue polo shirts will be mandatory.
6. Marching Unit Picture Day Flyer – The Marching Unit will take a formal group photo on Wednesday, September 07, 2022. Individual photos will also be available. The photo order form will be passed out to students during the first week of school. This is for marching band and color guard members only.
7. Schedule of Ensembles Contribution & Costs – This sheet summarizes the costs to be a member of any ensemble within the Instrumental Music Program.
8. Bingo Program – This document describes each music family's expected and necessary commitment to Bingo, **our major fundraiser for all ensembles**. The funds raised help to defray costs for all ensembles including Symphony Orchestra, Jazz Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble, Color Guard and Thundering Mustangs Marching Unit. This fundraiser is not only vital to the financial health of the music boosters, but also to the quality of the music education and experience for each student. As such, we require each family within the music program work at least one shift a month.

The Saddleback Valley Unified School District is very proud of the extensive co-curricular programs offered at the comprehensive high schools. If additional funds to augment the program are not raised in the amount noted above, the school may find it necessary to scale back the program. We are strongly encouraging all parents to contribute to the program. Remember, your contributions may be tax deductible. Please consult with your accountant or tax advisor for specifics.

Additionally, parents and students may be asked to participate in fundraising activities throughout the year in an effort to provide even greater financial support for the program. Participation is highly encouraged. However, lack of participation in these fundraising activities by a parent or guardian will not affect their student's ability to participate.

WELCOME TO THHS BINGO!

It's our 12th Anniversary this year!!!! The Music Boosters started bingo as a fundraiser to help support our AWARD-WINNING MUSIC Program. It has become one of the most popular bingo sites in Orange County!

Bingo is EXCLUSIVE to the Music program. All profits go into the THHS Music program.

This is serious BINGO! Payouts range from \$250 - \$1,199. We average 100 players every Thursday and many of them are regulars. The players like the special attention they receive from the volunteers.

Bingo is every Thursday, 3:30 p.m. - 10:15 p.m. AS CRAZY AS IT SOUNDS . . . It takes a minimum of 30-volunteers each Thursday night to run bingo successfully. On average we have 100 players a night! FOR REAL!!!

Why Bingo?

- Bingo started as a supplemental fundraiser for the music program. It has grown into our largest fundraiser for the THHS music program. BUT, it is not our only source of fundraising.
- The Music Director is given an annual budget from the school district to run the program. However, the district budget only covers the basic curriculum, meaning it covers basic music classes and nothing more. **It does not cover the cost of additional activities that help shape our kids and give them a robust music experience: coaches, festivals, concerts, competitions, performance events, transportation to events, family pot luck, awards dinner and so much more. These additional events are what makes the THHS MUSIC experience so impactful on our kids.**
- NOTE: Funds from BINGO support ALL Ensembles – Marching Unit, Color Guard, Percussion Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Strings, Intermediate Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Pep Band

How can I help?

- No Joke! We need 30 volunteers each Thursday night, but not all night.
- Help is needed from 3:30-10:30pm. There are many jobs and shifts. You can see the many shifts at <http://signup.com/go/HQXdNq>
- There are many positions and shifts that need coverage (See table on next page). The Opening and Closing Shifts are the hardest to get coverage.
- HEY, we need a couple of Dad's that can come in to set up the audio, boards and caller table at 3:30. THIS IS A MUST!
- No experience is necessary, just a friendly attitude and willingness to help.
- **If one parent from all ensembles works 1 shift at bingo once a month, we will always be fully covered.**

- You will be moving, so wear comfortable shoes.
- Never worked Bingo? No worries! Training is available.
