GETTING TO BECKMAN HIGH SCHOOL

From the North: South on the 5 Freeway, exit Jamboree, left. To El Camino, right. School will be on the left.

From the South: North on the 5 Freeway, exit Jamboree, right. To El Camino, right. School will be on the left.

Please refer to the campus maps that are attached. Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your assigned warm up time. All buses will unload in the student bus drop off on El Camino Real.

AREA RESTRICTIONS

Please realize that Beckman High School is in session during the festival. It is imperative that chaperones always STAY with your students. You are welcomed and encouraged to bring your group into the Performing Arts Center to hear other groups perform, however please remember that they will be seated just in front of the adjudicators. Please no food or drinks in the PAC. Your students MAY NOT wander around our school during the day and MUST STAY within the 300 wing and the check-in area ONLY.

PLEASE ASK YOUR STUDENTS NOT TO BRING VALUABLES TO FESTIVAL!!

SCORES & MUSIC LISTS

Part of my agreement with SCSBOA stipulates that I must inspect all scores to be used to ensure there are no copyright infringements. Please remember to bring 3 original scores of each song that you plan to perform with your school's name on them and with all measure numbers marked. If for some reason you can't obtain a score in time or must make photocopies, please make sure the photocopied score is accompanied by a letter from the publisher giving you permission to use a temporary copy (Pepper is helpful with this). Sorry, no exceptions.

Please make sure you go the following links, <u>UIL Lists</u> & <u>SCSBOA Approved Music Lists</u> and review <u>Music Selection Guidelines</u> to make sure you are programming appropriately for your festival performance.

EQUIPMENT/PERCUSSION FURNISHED

We will be furnishing the following percussion equipment on stage in the PAC for your performance. Grand Piano 5 Timpani Concert Bass Drum Gong Xylophone Marimba Glockenspiel Vibraphone (with motor) Each group will provide their own sticks and mallets, snare drums, cymbals, and small percussion. *Please don't take any of my equipment and don't leave any of yours!!* We will of course have chairs, stands, and a conductor's podium for your use. However, the sooner I get your stage set up, the better I can plan to have enough chairs and stands in both the warm-up room and the clinic room (I hate it when schools have only 3 stands in the warm-up room!). Please email me if you have any special needs.

The clinic room will also have a bass drum, snare drum, 2 timpani, vibraphone, and a small glockenspiel.

EVALUATION

All three adjudicators will be making comments on your performance. The adjudicators for the day are:

Festival ratings and judges' sheets will be made available approximately 30 minutes after your performance (after clinic). After your performance, there will be a clinic with one of the judges that adjudicated your performance (no sight reading). All SCSBOA Festivals use digital recorders and post judges' comments on competition suite. As has been the case lately, there will be no posting of scores in public.

Also, of note, as a middle school teacher for 16 years and as a former SCSBOA Vice President of Junior High and Elementary Education, I have noticed a philosophical divide in what is expected from novice groups. If you believe you have such a group (class E, or new program, or you are a new teacher), I urge you to consider coming for comments only instead of a rating, and having your students attend the performance of at least 1 other group. A festival is just that, a festival not a competition. However, as educational as we try to make the environment, competitiveness still exists. You need to gauge where you and your group is and review the rubric that your group will be evaluated by.

INSTRUMENT CASES

We will have an area to store cases in room 320 near check-in. They may not be stored in the warm up room, as new groups will be coming in and out. We will have designated students & parents keeping an eye on cases, however we will not be responsible for valuables.

FOOD

There will be snacks and drinks available in the patio area directly outside of the warmup and clinic rooms.

MEDALS, PINS, PATCHES & STICKERS

Please tell your students to bring money for stickers (\$1), patches (\$5), pins (\$8) and medals (\$8). The sale of medals, pins, and stickers helps support SCSBOA and our music program.

FINALLY:

If you're reading this far, bravo! I'm old school; the digital age is convenient, but only if you sit down and actually read and make notes somewhere. I prefer to print things out and write marginalia, but to each his own. However, the big problem I see these days is that there is a wealth of information out there and people are simply not taking the time to read things completely (yes, I've been guilty of this too).

I highly recommend you read these if you are new to our profession or have never sat down and read them completely. Beware: you might learn something!

One of the things that I'm proud of is that for 18 years, I've run this festival a bit differently, that is there actually is an audience at times. Please bring in your groups and have them sit through another group's performance; this is a great time to teach concert etiquette. Also, if you see something you like or a good idea, feel free to take a photo or make note of it (and it wouldn't hurt to tell me that you appreciate something we do!). If you see something you don't like, then feel free to take a photo or make a note (and it wouldn't hurt to tell me what isn't working quite right).

I revised this letter in March of 2024 after the festival we had a year ago. I am serious about making things better. Thanks for reading! I hope we can give you a great festival experience!
