Dr. Leo Sakomoto is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Instrumental Studies at California State University, Bakersfield. He conducts the Concert Band, Symphonic Band, the Bakersfield College/CSUB Orchestra, directs the Pep Band, and teaches courses in music education and conducting. He also teaches conducting courses for the CSUB Kodály Institute. Under his leadership, the CSUB instrumental area has received several honors, including recognition from the College Band Directors National Association. Dr. Sakomoto was recently appointed as Conductor of the Bakersfield Youth Symphony Orchestra, beginning his tenure with the 2023-2024 concert season. Dr. Sakomoto received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Music Education from California State University, Los Angeles. He received his Doctor of Musical Arts and Master of Music degrees in conducting from UCLA under the mentorship of Dr. Thomas Lee. In addition to his degrees, Dr. Sakomoto is certified in the Kodály Method through the Organization of American Kodály Educators. Dr. Sakomoto maintains an active schedule as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator in both band and orchestra settings. Guest conducting engagements include ensembles in California, Texas, South Carolina, and Tennessee, and Ecuador. He has been an invited participant in conducting competitions in Finland and Poland. He is active as a conference presenter, previously lecturing on wind band repertoire and conducting, and most recently presenting a clinic on rehearsal efficiency through conducting at the California All-State Music Educators Conference. Awards received include Outstanding College/University Music Educator and Music Educator of the Year, both from the Kern County Music Educators Association.
