### **FESTIVAL POLICIES**

- 1. Due to limited space, all instrument cases should remain on the buses, or in designated rooms (portable classroom outside the music building for intermediate schools, instrumental locker room for high schools).
- 2. Chaperones or High School student leaders must supervise students at all times.
- 3. Students are expected to remain in the Theater to give each ensemble a large audience.
- 4. Help students clean up and pick up trash during snack breaks and lunch.
- 5. Students must use the buddy system when excused to use the restrooms.
- 6. Students must remain in performance attire as there are no changing facilities on site.
- 7. Each instrumental ensemble is scheduled as follows:

#### 1. Warm-up

- a. MVHS Band Room: 30 min including transition time.
- 2. *Performance*: 30 minutes for set-up, tuning, performance, and stage exit.

- •ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST REMAIN OFF Please check that all student electronics are powered OFF while inside the Theater.
- •REMAIN SEATED UNTIL THE END OF EACH PERFORMANCE Students may not be excused for the restroom or for a snack or meal in between pieces as this distracts the judges and performers on stage.

•ONLY IN AN EMERGENCY SHOULD A STUDENT BE EXCUSED DURING A PERFORMANCE

•TICKETS ARE NOT REQUIRED

• STUDENTS MUST REMAIN IN THE THEATER TO LISTEN & SUPPORT OTHER ENSEMBLES

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFO:
