Please be aware of the following logistical items:

- At the day of the festival, please remember to bring:
 - 1. 3 ORIGINAL scores for each piece you are performing. Copies will be accepted for pieces out of print or scores that have not arrived yet **ONLY IF** they are accompanied with a letter of permission to copy from the publisher or sheet music vendor. Please understand that just because something is on IMSLP, it doesn't mean you have permission to print. To print, the piece must be public domain AND the publisher has to have stopped printing (and you would need verification from that publisher that it is OK to print).
 - 2. Your percussion/equipment needs that are not listed below
- Please note, this is a clinic festival. There will be no sight-reading.
- Food will be served. Due to contractual obligations with Food Services, our boosters may not sell food until 3:00. We will sell burgers, hot dogs, snacks, and other traditional 'snack bar fare.'

If you need to eat lunch at the site before 3:00, I recommend that students bring a sack lunch, and we will provide an area for them to eat. Please notify me in advance if you are doing this so I can prepare an area for you.

- I know that buses sometimes present a problem, but if you can, please plan on staying to watch a few groups. Nobody likes to play for an audience of 3-4 people, and it show great support for all groups. The audiences for the first groups at the start of the day or just following a lunch/dinner break are traditionally very light, so please consider arriving early if you can to support all of our groups. For evening groups that are having students drive, please make a point for them to stay and watch all groups to the end of the festival.
- We are very proud of the acoustical environment that we are able to offer you. Please take a moment of your warmup time to leave the podium and walk into the hall. You will find a great deal of clarity in the sound and excellent reverb, but most groups find the percussion ESPECIALLY THE SNARE DRUM to cut through the ensemble more than they are normally used to in their rehearsal environment or regular performance space. Also, consider turning down any electronic keyboards or pointing your amps towards the shell as the attacks tend to be very predominant in our hall (depending on the patch). Please afford yourself the opportunity to hear the hall as an audience member would and prepare the students to make any necessary adjustments. You will sound great in our hall, but some adjustments may be necessary for you to take full advantage of what the hall can offer you.
- SJHHS will provide the following equipment. If you have any special requests, please notify me before the festival date to see if I can accommodate you. Please bring all of your own mallets, sticks, as well as small percussion instruments.

<u>Clinic Room</u>: Chairs, Stands, 1 Vibraphone, 1 Marimba, 4 timpani, 1 podium, 1 Wenger conductor stand, and a marching bass drum

Parking:

When you arrive on campus, busses should follow the road all the way down to the front of the school (La Pata, the road you take to the school entrance is along the back of the school). The road will take you down to the front of the theater (the big white building that's impossible to miss). Busses will be instructed where to park if they are staying.

Parents or anyone driving personal cars MUST PARK IN THE STAFF LOT. To get to the staff lot, parents will make the first right after turning on Stallion Ridge. This is after the church and before the baseball field. Continue down to the end of the parking lot and park in a space or curb by the tennis courts nearest the stadium. From there, it's a short walk down the hill to the theater entrance. After 12:45, individual cars may park in the main parking lot in front of the theater. Before 12:45, the main lot is for students only, and cars parked there will be ticketed.

Please also note heavy traffic volume at the following times:

- 8:00-8:30, morning dropoff
- 12:37-1:00 lunch
- 3:10-3:45 end of school pickup

You can arrive/leave at these times, but traffic will be heavy. I suggest you plan to avoid these times

We hope you and your students will be able to listen to other groups to get the full festival experience. Please have enough parents available for supervision of your groups. Please review the proper festival theater behavior with your students and parents (audience decorum, no phones, no feet on seats in front of them, no food or drink in the theater, etc). Lastly, please go over parking directions with your parents. We have been fortunate to offer a smooth-running festival for years, but if an issue arises, it's usually over parents being upset over the parking – and their expression of such with a campus supervisor.
